Offering an interfaith perspective, this special course integrates the wisdom and insights of Transpersonal and Jungian psychology and the opportunity to practice skills for serving as a spiritual guide to others, and for deepening one's own spiritual foundation. The training is for those called to spiritual guidance and will also benefit those working in medical, religious, teaching and helping professions by broadening their understanding of spiritual development. It is a gathering place for those who have experienced considerable inner work and who value sharing the journey of the soul within a community of other mature seekers.

Program themes include: call and vocation, myth, God ideal, shadow, typology and spiritual practice, dreams, the seeker-guide relationship, the structure of ritual, stages and states of the spiritual journey, intimacy and relationships, and the retreat process.

Thomas Atum O'Kane is a graduate of the Guild for Spiritual Guidance, holds a MA in Psychological Counseling, and a PhD in Transpersonal Psychology. Atum served as Secretary-General for 12 years in the Sufi Order International. He leads workshops, retreats and pilgrimages in North America, Europe, Asia, and The Holy Lands.
